This year's Nature Fest will be held on Saturday June 3 and Sunday June 4, 2023. This event occurs in conjunction with the 29th Annual Nature Photo Club Foto Fest. The outdoor market will be set up on the middle parking deck.

We appreciate your support for this event and will do everything we can to make it an enjoyable and successful one for you. We look forward to working with you!

Setup Options for Nature Fest 2023:

- Indoor Spot: Available for 2-Day Participation: An indoor space accommodates an at 8-foot table. Indoor spaces are only available for vendors who participate on both Saturday and Sunday. Indoor spaces cannot be made available for vendors who register for only one day. A limited number of indoor spaces are available. If you need accommodations for setting up indoors, please contact Laura@WildernessCenter.org.
 - **2-Day Participation: Indoor: \$100. Availability of indoor spaces is limited.**
- Pull-Up Spot: A pull-up spot accommodates a 10' x 10' tent. TWC does not have tents available. Vendors need to supply their own tents. However, a tent is not a requirement for participation. The event will go on rain or shine, so please plan accordingly. **ALL TENTS MUST BE SECURELY WEIGHTED DOWN.** A minimum of 50lbs of weight is necessary on all tents. Vendors will be able park near their setup space. Vendors must fully tear down their booths / tents at the end of the event on Saturday and are not permitted to leave anything overnight. However, TWC may have some storage available onsite. If you need accommodations for onsite storage, please contact Laura@WildernessCenter.org.
 - **2-Day Participation: \$60. An additional 10' space may be purchased for \$10.**
 - **1-Day Participation: \$45. An additional 10' space may be purchased for \$10.**
- PLEASE NOTE:
 - TWC does not have overnight security.
 - TWC is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged items.
 - Volunteers will be available in the morning and evening both days.
 - This is a rain or shine event.
 - Vendors are encouraged to participate in the outdoor spaces both days.



Guidelines for Vendors

General

- Items for sale must be made from natural materials or depict a nature theme as determined by the TWC team.
- Vendor agrees to remove from display and sale those articles of any objectionable nature as determined by the TWC team.
- TWC shall not be responsible for fire, theft, or injury.

Booth Details

- TWC will strive to accommodate your individual setup. However, if your setup is large or deep, then you may need to purchase two spaces.
- TWC has a limited number of tables available at no extra charge.
- Spaces are assigned based on the products and layout of the show, not on a first-come-first-served basis.
- Power tools or noxious substances are prohibited.
- Ideally, booth decorations should support the nature theme.

Setup and Teardown Timelines

- Setup begins Saturday, June 3 at 7 am. Any vehicles that need to be moved from the market space must be moved by 8:15 am. Vehicles that are permitted to be parked in pull-up spots must be parked by 8:15 am. Vendors must be ready to sell by 8:45 am. All items need to be removed and secured by 4:30 pm on Saturday, June 3.
- Setup begins Sunday, June 4 at 9 am. Any vehicles that need to be moved from the market space must be moved by 10:15 am. Vehicles that are permitted to be parked in pull-up spots must be parked by 10:15 am. Vendors must be ready to sell by 10:45 am. Vendors need to clear their space by 5 pm on Sunday June 4

Payment Information

- After approving your Nature Fest application, the TWC team will reach out to you with payment details. Payment can be made via check or online to secure your space.

Other Details

- This event is free for the public, so please invite all your friends and family to enjoy shopping this unique, nature-centric mart in The Wilderness Center's beautiful natural setting!
- As in previous years, there will be a raffle that spotlights vendors who have donated an item the raffle and generates proceeds to support TWC.
- As the event approaches, TWC will share details regarding any food vendors that we are able to secure for this event.
